MEMAC Resolution

The clerk read a resolution for the Michigan Emergency Management Assistance Compact Act. This authorizes the State and its political subdivisions to provide emergency aid and assistance in the event of a disaster or emergency. Dunbar made a motion to adopt the resolution. The motion was supported by Bohnsack. The motion passed all voting aye.

At the weekly sewer meetings it was suggested to have the council recommend the PUB to review Ordinance 8 for possible amendment concerning the section on existing pop ups for weep tile drainage. Comstock made a motion to have the PUB write an amendment for Ordinance 8 to connect the sump pump to the storm sewer that are currently pumping in their yard. The motion was supported by Dunbar.
