

Minutes – June 5, 2013

- C. Inman called the meeting to order at 5:30pm and called roll.
- S. Mitchell made a motion to accept the minutes. W. Kernstock seconded the motion. Passed.

Old Business:

- The Tigers game will be on August 2<sup>nd</sup>. V. Perez brought the tickets in. C. Inman secured the bus for the game at a cost of \$950.00. Need to change the resident sign-up period for the game, it will begin on July 15<sup>th</sup> through the 23<sup>rd</sup> (\$40 residents / \$45 for non-residents)
- The Kalahari sign-ups will begin on June 6<sup>th</sup>. The bus is secured for that trip at a cost of \$1,700.

New Business:

- W. Kernstock met with Vanessa Warren & City Manager Zittel regarding the riverfront grant and reported that the grant is over budget (\$7,000 over). Part of the parking lot will be crushed concrete to help save money. V. Warren will check with Miracle about playscape layout to see if it can be rearranged to lessen the cost of fencing. We are still waiting for funds to be released.
  - City Wide Garage sale will be listed on Craigslist and advertised on multiple Facebook pages as well as fliers at area businesses. Sign-ups are at city hall with the last day to be listed on the sales map being July 26<sup>th</sup> (to allow time to create the map).
  - J. Owens made motion to have an eight week, Facebook page, scavenger hunt which would be open to residents between the ages of three & seventeen. Resident's grandchildren may participate as well. This would be to get kids out and exploring the parks. Each week an item in a picture would need to be located in one of the three parks and the child to take a picture with the subject of the picture and post it to the Parks & Recreation Facebook page to win. A \$5.00 McDonalds gift card will be awarded each week. Motion passed. J. Owens will get gift cards and coordinate.
  - S. Mitchell stated that Lori, a fitness instructor, would like to use our parks to have classes at all levels. She is certified and insured and will create her own schedule.
  - J. Owens suggested a possible 5k to benefit Parks & Rec and another non-profit (animal shelter, etc.) to help fund activities along the bike path. Will discuss again at the August meeting.
