

Minutes – May 7, 2015

- S. Mitchell called the meeting to order at 6:04pm.

Review of minutes:

- S. Mitchell made a motion to accept the minutes. D. Krzyzaniak seconded motion.

Old Business:

- Playground – S. Mitchell stated that the playground is out for bid and that we need three (3) quotes to submit to the state.
- Detroit Tigers game – D. Krzyzaniak stated that we secured tickets & bus for the August 22nd game (vs. the Rangers). (Indian Trails stated that next year they can get game tickets reserved in February if we purchase through them, before sales open to the public. They also have a website with other excursions if we would be interested. www.tourtimeus.com) E. Turner made a motion that ticket cost will remain \$35.00 for residents and \$40 for non-residents, D. Krzyzaniak 2nd motion. Motion passed. D. Krzyzaniak stated that board member Wendy Kernstock will make the sign-up sheet for residents. Sign-up will begin, for residents July 27th and go through August 7th. If bus is not full, non-residents may sign up August 10th-21st. S. Mitchell noted that two of the tickets/bus seats will go to Zilwaukee resident Alicia Flynn for winning the hula hoop contest at the 2014 Zilwaukee Homecoming.
- Casino Trip – The bus holds thirty (30) people and there will be an extra \$72 based on what we charged for the excursion. No monies from Parks & Rec were used for this trip. S. Mitchell made a motion to purchase items for goodie bags for each of the passengers (& the bus driver) to get when they get on board. D. Krzyzaniak 2nd motion. Motion passed with purchasing a variety pack of chips, waters, mints and a \$1.00 lottery ticket for each bag.
- Budget Meeting – S. Mitchell stated that she did not attend a budget meeting on April 22nd so we do not have any further information on that.

New Business:

- Homecoming 2015– S. Mitchell stated that Zilwaukee based business, PetStayHome, will sell popcorn in the beer tent during the evening. The school will donate the popper and PetStayHome will donate the popcorn and provide the labor. ½ of the proceeds will go to the school and ½ will go to the zoo. S. Mitchell also stated that Zilwaukee School teacher, MaryKay Kartz's fifth grade class is considering selling cotton candy during the afternoon.
