- W. Kernstock called the meeting to order at 6:03pm and called roll.
  - Reviewed April minutes. E. Turner made a motion to accept the minutes, W. Kernstock seconded the motion. Passed.

Old Business:

- Tigers game: The bus will be approximately \$990.00 for each game. The games will be June 6<sup>th</sup> and August 15<sup>th</sup> - both on Fridays with fireworks after the game. Cost will be \$35 for residents and \$40 for non-residents. (section 144 - June 6<sup>th</sup>, section 149 - August 15<sup>th</sup>) May 12-23<sup>rd</sup> will be resident sign-up, non-residents may sign up May 26<sup>th</sup> - June 5<sup>th</sup> for the June 6<sup>th</sup> game. For the August 15<sup>th</sup> game, resident sign up will be July 21<sup>st</sup> - August 1<sup>st</sup> if you didn't attend the June 6<sup>th</sup> game, if you are a resident and attended the June 6<sup>th</sup> game you may not sign up until after August 1<sup>st</sup>. June 6<sup>th</sup> is vs. the Red Sox, August 15<sup>th</sup> is vs. the Mariners.
- J. Owens will contact Mitchell Motor coach, Blue Lakes, and Indian Trails about bus costs for Cedar Point and Michigan's Adventure. We will table the trip pricing until a vote is taken on Facebook, by the residents, as to which location they would prefer to go to and until bus pricing is available.
- Casino trip - the bus is full and the trip is May 12<sup>th</sup> - it uses no tax payer dollars.
- Capital improvement plans: lighting for Adams/Johnson "old town" area. We are waiting for Consumers Energy to sign off on the improvements for the river front.
- Howard Burkhart and Jason Kopka addressed the board regarding the car show in Zilwaukee in conjunction with parks & recreation. It is scheduled for August 2<sup>nd</sup> at Zilwaukee School, they have secured the location with Principal Munoz. The top ten cars will receive ribbons. It will cost approximately \$150.00 for trophies. They will be at the meeting to bring information back on port-o-potties, trophies and to finalize the details of the event.
