Waste Management Increase

Waste Management has increased the cost of refuse pick-up per household by \$5.00. This will increase the quarterly bill to \$36.00. The Administrator requested that the refuse fee be removed from the quarterly water bill and added on to the winter tax as a yearly fee effective 2015. A motion was made by Boese to approve the increase and move the refuse bill to the winter tax bill effective 2015. The motion was supported by Luplow. The motion passed. Voting aye: Boese, Bohnsack, Comstock, Luplow and M/Jolin. Voting nay: none
