The administrator reported that Mid-Michigan Waste Authority is in the process of making a decision regarding trash, recycling and yard waste collection. They have received four proposals. She also stated that she has received an email from the City of Saginaw regarding future water rates. They suggested taking an average of the past three years of price hikes. She reminded the council of the budget meeting to be held on April 12th at 9:00 a.m. She informed the council that the city had received a vacuum truck through the government program. She also informed the council that according to the 2020 program the population had dropped to 1,543 residents. This will result our current year's revenue and our revenue for the next current year.

The mayor mentioned that the parks and recreation board will be holding a coffee klatch at the community hall on March 21st from 9:00 until 11:00.
