Old Business:

- Thanksgiving Bingo – will be at the Community Hall, November 15th at 7:00pm. We will have popcorn at bingo for the first time. - Zilwaukee Rocks – K. Rowland questions if we will be doing rocks in October. We tabled the rock painting to January or February as a possible activity for cabin fever.
- Iron Belle Trail – M. Bourbina stated that there is another meeting coming up and that Carrollton should be putting up their signs soon. Carrollton got a grant for signs and it includes Zilwaukee’s portion of the trail. Zilwaukee will maintain the bike trail portion.
