Purchase of Property

The Administrator presented a proposal of a half acre of property on the corner of Schust and Sherman for the purpose of relocating the pump station that is currently located across the street. The cost is \$7,500.00 for the half acre. A motion was made by Boese and seconded by Luplow to purchase the property. The motion passed. Voting aye: Boese, Comstock, Luplow and M/Jolin.

Assessor

The State of Michigan has sent letters concerning our assessor about reports filed with them. They stated that they did not agree with his submissions. After meetings with the state they still did not agree. Their decision was to suspend our assessor's license and get the situation resolved. One suggestion was to get a new assessor that would come in and take over the assessing until the issue is resolved. The other suggestion was to have the state take over. The administrator was unable to get a new assessor at a reasonable price. A motion was made by Luplow and supported to request the state to assume the assessing to their satisfaction. The motion passed. Voting aye: Boese, Comstock, Luplow and M/Jolin.

A motion was made by Comstock and seconded by Luplow to adjourn. The meeting was adjourned at 5:05 p.m.
