

Zilwaukee City Council Meeting
November 14th, 2022
Zilwaukee City Hall

The meeting was called to order at 3:00 p.m. by Mayor Eugene Jolin

Members Present: C/Bohnsack, C/Comstock, C/Heck, C/Luplow and M/Jolin.

The purpose of the meeting was to swear in the elected council members and elect mayor and mayor pro-tem for fiscal year 2022/23.

The clerk swore in Bohnsack and Heck for a 4-year term and Comstock for a two-year term to the city council.

The clerk asked for nominations for mayor. Comstock nominated Eugene Jolin for mayor. A motion was made by Comstock and seconded by Bohnsack to close the nominations and elect Eugene Jolin mayor. The motion passed. Voting aye: Bohnsack, Comstock, Heck, Luplow and Jolin. Voting nay: none.

The clerk then asked for nominations for mayor pro-tem. Bohnsack nominated Luplow for mayor pro-tem. A motion was made by Comstock and seconded by Heck to close the nominations and elect Luplow mayor pro-tem. The motion passed. Voting aye: Bohnsack, Comstock, Heck, Luplow and M/Jolin.

M/Jolin then asked for approval to keep the city's bank accounts at Chase, 5th Third, Independent for the city and Huntington for the Fire Department. A motion was made by Bohnsack and seconded by Luplow to approve the recommendations. The motion passed. Voting aye: Bohnsack Comstock, Heck, Luplow and M/Jolin. Voting nay: none

The mayor then asked for the reappointment of Luplow and Comstock to the Personnel and Finance committee with Luplow as chair and Bohnsack and Heck to the Building/Infrastructure committee with Bohnsack the chair. A motion was made by Comstock and seconded by Luplow to approve the appointments. The motion passed. Voting aye: Bohnsack, Comstock, Heck, Luplow and M/Jolin. Voting nay: none.

Community Hall Parking Lot

Gary Neithhammer from D&M Site was in attendance to resubmit the design for the community hall parking lot. After discussion a motion was made by Luplow and seconded by Bohnsack to allow D&M Site to ask for bids to be submitted for the parking lot at the community building. The motion passed. Voting aye: Bohnsack, Comstock, Heck, Luplow and M/Jolin. Voting nay: none.
