WELCOME to our newest employee, Officer Taya Catherwood. Taya is excited to be a part of the Zilwaukee Police Department.


WATER BILLS- Water bills are being estimated this quarter with an average being calculated over the past year. You will see any necessary adjustments made in the following water bill.
